

ENERGY POLICY STATEMENT

This Energy Policy has been prepared in consultation with internal stakeholders and interested parties and with the support of the Management Board. It applies to both UK sites — Siderise Insulation Limited (Maesteg, Wales) and Siderise (Special Products) Limited (Hadleigh, Suffolk) — and provides the framework for an Energy Management System (EnMS) in accordance with ISO 50001:2018.

1. Purpose and Scope

For over 50 years, Siderise has been providing innovative solutions for fire, acoustic, and thermal applications. Our mission is to go beyond, contributing to safer buildings.

We recognise that our production processes, facilities, and supporting activities are energy intensive.

This policy applies to all operations under Siderise's control, including energy consumed through purchased electricity, fossil fuels, and other relevant sources.

2. Commitments

- **Leadership & Compliance**
Top management is committed to supporting the effective implementation of the EnMS and complying with all applicable legal and other requirements related to energy use, consumption, and efficiency.
- **Resource Availability**
We will ensure the availability of information and necessary resources to achieve our energy objectives and targets.
- **Continual Improvement**
We are committed to continually improving both our energy performance and the effectiveness of our EnMS through monitoring, review, and implementation of appropriate actions.
- **Objectives and Targets**
We will set and review energy objectives and measurable targets, taking into account operational, financial, and technological factors, as well as business priorities.
- **Design and Procurement**
We will ensure that energy performance improvement opportunities are considered when designing or modifying facilities, equipment, systems, and processes, and when procuring energy-related products and services.

3. Communication and Awareness

This policy will be communicated to all persons working for or on behalf of Siderise to ensure awareness of their roles in improving energy performance. It will be made available externally to interested parties via appropriate channels, including the corporate website.

4. Implementation and Review

The Energy Management Representative and Energy Management Committee will oversee the implementation of this policy.

This policy will be reviewed at least annually, or when there are significant changes in operations, legal requirements, or other relevant factors.
